**HISTORY MINOR REQUIREMENTS:** Seven (7) *distinct* History courses at the 100-, 200- or 300-level; four (4) of these courses must be INSIDE CONCENTRATION; three (3) are OUTSIDE CONCENTRATION. Further, at least *three* (3) of the seven courses must be at the 300-level, and at least *two* (2) of the INSIDE CONCENTRATION courses must be at the 300-level. No more than one (1) 100-level (History Department First-Year Seminar) may be applied to the minor.

**History Minor Areas of Concentration are: Africa, Europe (including Britain), Latin America, Asia, Middle East, United States, Economics and Labor, Law and Crime, Science and Technology, Environment**

**(a)** History courses taught in other departments or programs by core History faculty, visiting History faculty, or History lecturers (e.g., Gender & Sexuality Studies 230-0 when taught by history faculty);

**(b)** Classics 211-0, 212-0; Economics 315-0 (dependent upon subject matter), 318-0, 323-1,-2, 324-0; Religious Studies 264-0, 265-0

**(c)** Combined (or cross-listed) classes may be taken for credit in one department only and may not be taken for repeat credit in the other department offering the course. It is recommended you enroll in the course on the History side to receive History credit.

**NOTE:** Chicago Field Studies courses may NOT count towards a history MINOR.

**NOTE:** WCAS does not permit double-counting between the History major and other "stand-alone" majors; double-counting is only allowed in the case of an adjunct major and then only as prescribed by that adjunct major. The History major itself has no double-counting provision. Generally, there is no double-counting between majors and minors; see the WCAS website for the list of exceptions. Other schools within the university (Medill, McCormick, SoC) have their own double-counting rules. Please review these rules as necessary.

**STUDY ABROAD:** Up to three courses completed on a study abroad program may be counted towards the minor with approval of a faculty advisor.
